

CAMP RULES

1. All campers are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with acceptable social standards (Common Courtesy).
2. To protect the scenic beauty of the property, removal of plants, animals and minerals *is* prohibited. The use of guns, hatchets and knives is also prohibited.
3. Parents will be held responsible for the activities and conduct of their children at all times. Children under the age of 18 are not allowed to stay at Camp without their parents or a responsible adult chaperone. (01/1981)
4. No smoking inside any building.
5. Dogs must be on a leash no longer that 6 feet all times and owners shall clean up after their own animals. No pets will be allowed inside the buildings, pool area or sleeping rooms at any time.
6. No motorbikes or off-road vehicles shall be operated on camp property. Wheeled shoes, skate boards, and roller blades will not be allowed anywhere on camp property.
7. Swimmers must abide by the rules posted at the swimming pool.
8. Garbage and trash must be placed in receptacles provided.
9. Rooms are to be left in a clean and orderly condition. Kitchens and social hall areas shall also be cleaned and left in an orderly manner.
10. Campers shall be held financially responsible for any property damage incurred by themselves or their family or pets.
11. Check-out time for rooms and camping spaces is 11:00 a.m. unless prior arrangements have been made with the Camp Manager. Check-in time for rooms and camping spaces is 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. (9:00 p.m. on weekdays and Sundays).
12. There will be no electronic sound equipment or amplification of music in the meadow area.
13. Sons of Norway Campers are required to show current membership cards at the time of registration.
14. Hiking is allowed only on designated "Nature Trails" and main roads. Feeding or petting of either feral cats or other wild animals is strictly prohibited for your own good. If bitten or scratched, report the incident to the Camp Manager to receive medical attention.
15. No open camp fires at any time. Fire pit to be used with consent of Manager depending upon current conditions and Fire Dept. rules.
16. No lit candles to be used anywhere in camp at any time.

INFRINGEMENT OF THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DENIAL OF USE OF THESE CAMP FACILITIES. THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RECREATION CENTER HAS VESTED FULL AUTHORITY WITH THE CAMP MANAGER TO ENFORCE ALL CAMP RULES, REGULATIONS AND POLICIES AS DIRECTED BY THE BOARD.
